



Dear UCC Campus Community,

In our continued commitment to keep you informed regarding UCC activity involving COVID-19, here are current College updates (as of Wednesday, March 25).

Note: This is the last update that will be sent this week. Campus updates will resume Monday, March 30.

During today's daily call with our state peers and the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC), the following items were discussed:

The governor's most-recent executive order includes requirements for retail businesses, non-profits, other business, and state-owned government buildings. Higher education institutions fall into none of these categories.

Regardless of falling into a specified category, UCC is following the governor's "[Stay Home, Save Lives](#)" executive order. One of the order's requirements is to establish, implement, and designate an official to enforce a social distancing policy. On the UCC campus, Human Resources Director Kelley Plueard and the campus' security officers are leading this effort for the minimal number of employees who remain on campus.

The Oregon State Police has shared information related to the "Stay Home, Save Lives" enforcement efforts.

Everyone is watching the federal government's stimulus package and what it means for higher education. Monitoring will continue; information will be shared moving forward.

Here are the latest actions at UCC:

- Maple Corner Montessori, located in the Ford Family Center on campus, is temporarily closed due to the governor's executive order. The school is not permanently closing.
- For students who need to pick up books and supplies through the Hawk Shop, details of a drive-through pick-up plan are being finalized. We do know the dates will be next Thursday and Friday, April 2 & 3, and Monday and Tuesday, April 6 & 7. The finalized plans will be shared early next week.
- Computer Labs are open for students who need access to a computer or the internet for the purposes of enrolling or online course participation. The labs, which are located in

Wayne Crooch Hall (WCH) Rooms 11, 12, and 17, are available from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

- [Social Distancing](#) in the labs is in effect.
