SUMMARY:

On Thursday, Sept. 12, Umpqua Community College (UCC), Douglas County Fire District #2, and representatives from the Douglas County Sheriff's Office will be conducting an emergency drill on the UCC campus. The drill is scheduled to start at 9 a.m. and end around noon.

During the drill, the College's Community & Workforce Training Center (CWT) building will be "set on fire" using smoke machines. The building will be evacuated and the campus Emergency Operations Center will be activated.

Nearby residents have been notified of the activities and a large, digital reader board is currently set up on Umpqua College Road displaying an advisory message.

The local media is welcome to cover this drill. A 'heads up' notice if you plan to participate is not required, however, a staging area will be set up and you will be asked to stay within that area. The Director of Communications and Marketing will be present for interview coordination.
