Statements from Audience:

Tamara Loosli, Dental Hygiene. Met with us regarding funding for holding regular dental clinics. These clinics would be helping part-time workers at UCC, students without insurance, or those whose insurance is cost prohibitive. In addition, we also discussed holding senior clinics for those who are also meeting similar criteria. They are pursuing an Autzen Grant, which needs to be filed by November 6th, which can provide a \$10,000 grant for the program, but this needs to show outside income, which is why she has come to the board with a request for funding. The funding is broken down by \$20,000 for instruments, \$1,000 in supplies, and various other costs (including marketing) to come to \$21,713 in total costs for the year. In addition she noted approximately \$1,000 as a year-over-year budget to operate. More funds could come from the UDS (Umpqua Dental Society). We deliberated and asked a number of questions, including frequency of the clinic, what services would be offered, and then put up a motion.

Motion: Catherine Blocher: Providing \$10,000 from our account towards the dental clinic, contingent upon receiving the grant, with ASUCC not responsible for the year-over-year costs. Motion is seconded by Kilburn. (15:0:0) Will receive the request for funds for next week.
