Course Placement

Placement tests cover reading, writing, and math. They take around two hours to complete, and the first attempt is free. The Placement Center has walk-in times, appointments, and has access to preparation materials. UCC utilizes multiple measures for recent HS graduates, using high school grades and your state assessment scores. umpqua.edu/take-placement-tests



Financial Aid

The UCC Financial Aid website has information on federal financial aid, links to UCC scholarships, and information on veterans benefits and work-study. It is important to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible, as there will likely be additional steps to complete through your student account. You can also earn a tuition waiver if you get involved in certain student activities, like Associated Students of UCC or Peer Mentors.
