Instructions: The point of this exercise is to help you form an honest assessment of how you are developing as a tutor. It is based on the premise that you want to be the very best you can be at what you do and that there is always room to improve. There is no right or wrong answers, and the only way to get the most out of the self-assessment is to engage in careful reflection and be honest and detailed in your responses. As a tutor you are required to complete this process at least once each term (fall, winter, and spring).

1. First, contact the Learning Skills Director, Terrance Bradford, for copies of the survey assessments completed by your students. Review the ratings and comments.
2. Second, select a tutoring session and complete this process. It is suggested that you select a session that is at the end of your shift and plan to complete this assessment immediately afterward while it is fresh in your mind. After you complete it, schedule a time to meet with Terrance for an assessment interview to discuss your results, reflections, and set goals.

This process is NOT intended to judge you; rather to help you celebrate your strengths and give you the support you need to work on areas that you would like to improve. Again, the key to getting the most out of it is to be honest in your response
